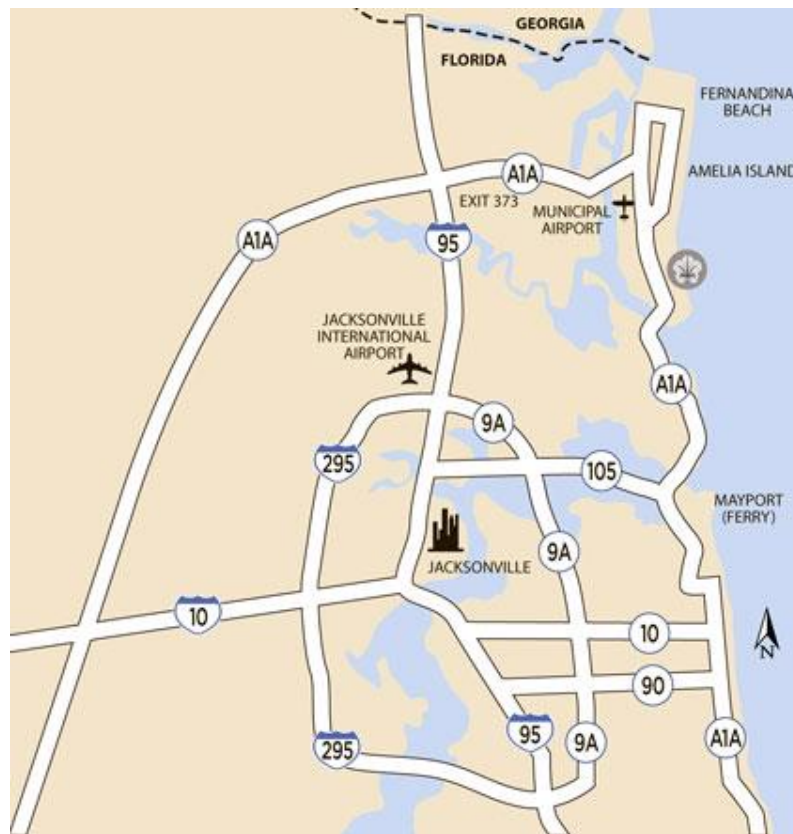

Omni Amelia Island Resort: Directions

By Car:

- The Resort is approximately 18 miles from I-95, Exit 373. Follow Rte. 200 (A1A) East across the Intercoastal Waterway Bridge. Then follow the signs directing you to the Omni Resort with a right after the bridge on Amelia Island Parkway before rejoining the A1A as Rte. 105 and proceeding toward the southern tip of Amelia Island. The Resort entrance will be on your left.
- From the Jacksonville International Airport. – The Resort is approximately 34 miles by I-295, I-95 South, 9A, 105 and A1A. Travel time is approximately 45 minutes.
- Private and corporate aircraft charters can also fly directly to Fernandina Beach Municipal Airport, four miles north of the Resort.

Navigating the Island

Most of Amelia Island is within the city limits of Fernandina Beach, Florida, the county seat of Nassau County. There are also a few unincorporated communities on Amelia Island, such as Amelia City, American Beach, and Franklinton.

The restaurants, amenities, and attractions on Amelia Island in this guide will be separated into three basic geographical areas:

Southern Resort Area

The Omni Resort is located near the southern tip of the island, with the Ritz Carlton Resort approximately 3.5 miles to the north on the A1A. There are additional golf courses stretching for a couple of miles north of the Ritz Carlton.

Central Island

This area of the island, stretching north from the Fernandina Beach Municipal Airport, has public beaches on its east side and a variety of businesses catering to the beachgoing crowds and the local community, including casual eateries, local shopping, and chain stores such as Winn-Dixie and Walmart.

Historic Downtown Fernandina Beach

In the northwestern portion of the island, approximately 10 miles from the Omni Resort (20-25 minutes by car), is a 50-block historic district with upscale and casual dining, shopping full of eclectic and independent shops, local history museums and markers, and local art.

Tram: A tram runs through the resort and will take you anywhere on the property, including the villas, the hotel lobby, the conference center, the village shops and restaurants, the tennis and racquet center, and the golf shop. The tram runs from about 6 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. You request a tram by dialing “0” from your room.

Walking: Most amenities can be reached by a less than 15-minute walk from the centrally located hotel, although the walk may be farther from one of the villas.

Driving: For those renting a car, there are parking locations near all the resort’s amenities. **SEALS self-parking rate is \$10 per day, a 50% discount from the typical self-parking rate.**

Amelia Island Playgrounds & Parks



Egan's Creek Greenway (*Local Favorite! Family Friendly!*)

A protected area of over 300 acres that runs north to south along Egans Creek. Its grass-covered roads serve as a network of trails for walking or bicycling, with a variety of natural wildlife and vegetation. Local wildlife, such as alligators, snakes, marsh rabbits, and birds, may be enjoyed from a distance.

Fort Clinch State Park (*Local Favorite! Family Friendly!*)

A well-preserved Civil War era fort and beautiful natural surroundings make up Fort Clinch State Park with daily tours, trails, biking and hiking, beach combing, sunbathing, swimming, and surf fishing. North Island; 2601 Atlantic Avenue

Original Town of Fernandina Historic Site (Old town)

Old Town Fernandina is a community of “peonia” lots platted by the Spanish in 1811 and is the only Spanish town in Florida with the original site plat remaining. Constructed of wood and earth, the Spanish Fort San Carlos was built on the riverfront in 1816. Today, visitors will find a large grassy lawn, known as Fernandina Plaza, offering one of the most scenic waterfront views available on this barrier island. North of Bosque Bello Historic cemetery; 1321 N 14th St.

Pirate Playground (*Local Favorite! Family Friendly!*)

Playground **for children of all abilities** set in a breezy, shaded area amongst the trees. Wheelchair accessible. Located behind the Atlantic Recreation Center and close to an entrance to Egan's Creek Greenway; 2500 Atlantic Avenue.

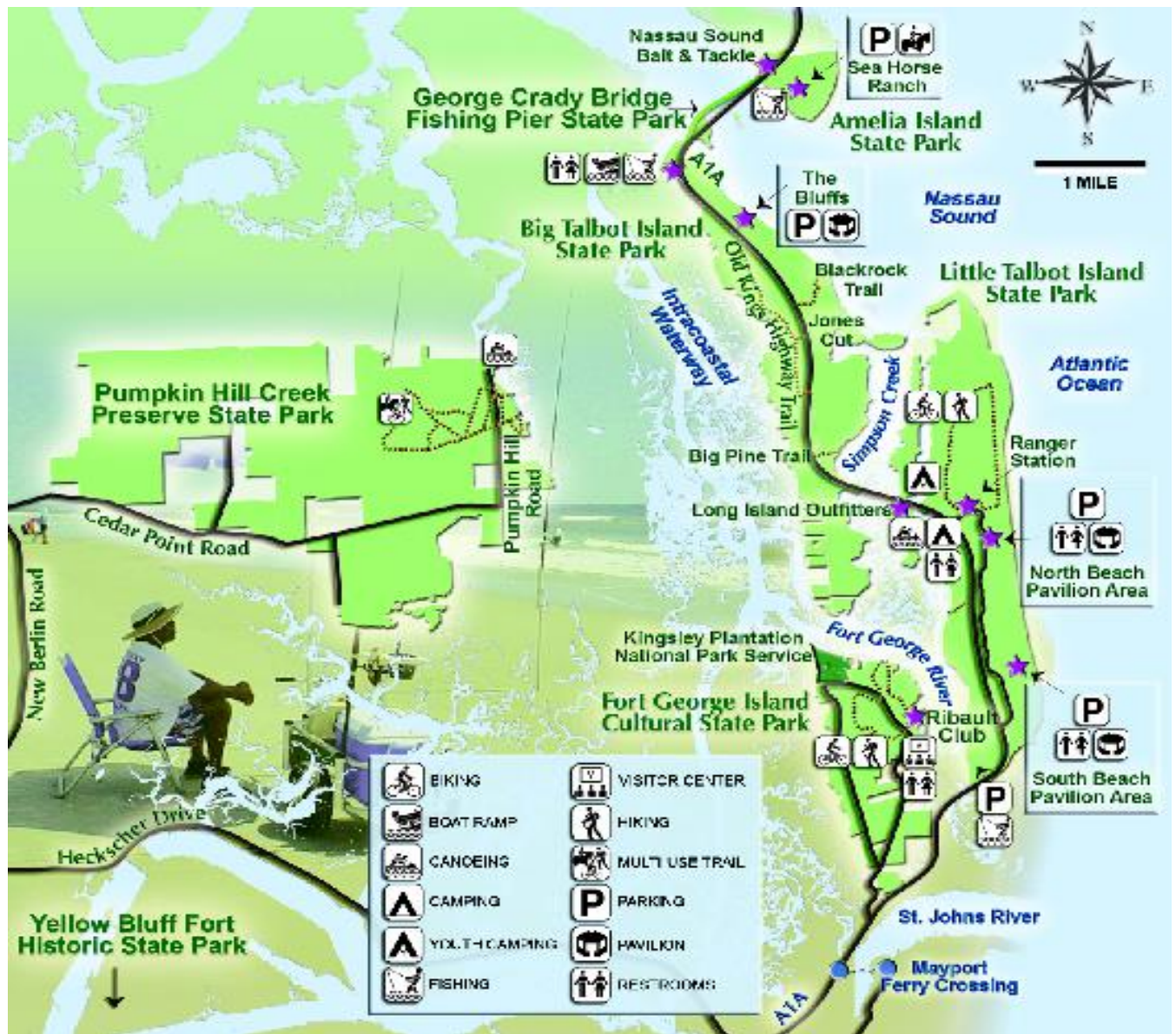

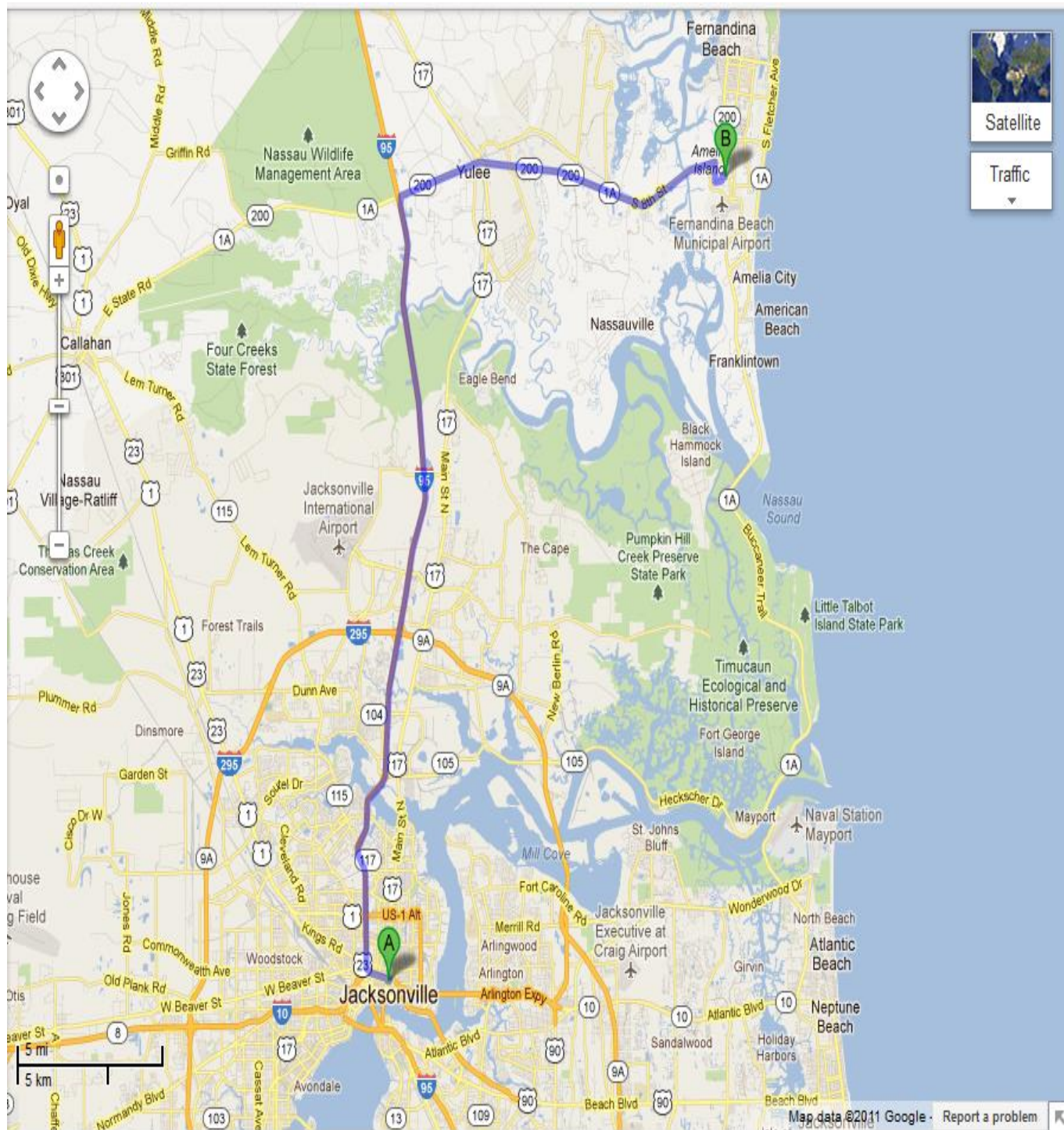
